

PRIEST'S CORNER

A MESSAGE FROM FR. LARRY:

A MESSAGE FROM FR. LARRY:

Most people associate Feb. 2nd with Groundhog Day, but for us the day celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. The offering of two doves indicates that Joseph and Mary could not provide a lamb and did not have any land on which to raise a lamb. The Holy Family was poor. Even though they were poor, they were still faithful to following the Law of Moses. Why did they not have any land? Remember, Jesus grew up in Nazareth, but Mary and Joseph had to travel to Bethlehem for the census because it was Joseph's ancestral home. The fact that Joseph did not live in Bethlehem meant that at some point in his family's history, they had lost their ancestral land. That makes a lot of sense, because at the time of Jesus, half of all the arable land in Palestine was owned by only about five families! Over time, land tended to consolidate in Palestine Over time, land tended to consolidate in Palestine because rich families would loan money at interest because rich families would loan money at interest (contrary to the Law!) to struggling farmers and would rig the court system to rule in their favor when debt disputes arose. (Sound familiar?) That is why there is so much emphasis in Jesus' teaching on forgiving debts. He's not merely talking about spiritual debts: He's talking about real monetary debts that drove large numbers of people to the brink of starvation. That's the original literal meaning of debts in the Lord's Prayer. That is why the Church, following Jesus' teaching, has always emphasized economic justice in her teachings. When Pope Francis today talks about income inequality today, he's not just blowing smoke. Even some Catholics criticize the Pope and think he should stick to "spiritual things", but that would be a betrayal of Jesus' teaching and example. Something to think about as you meditate on Mary and Joseph holding their two little doves today.
